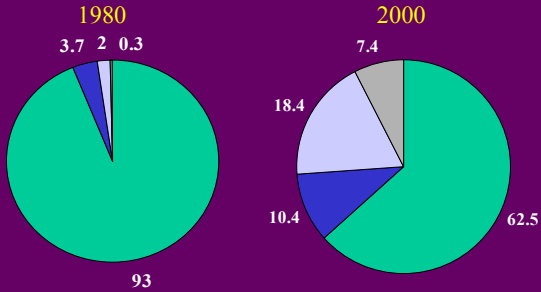


### In 2 Decades, Lynn Has Gone from Less than a Tenth to Over a Third Minority

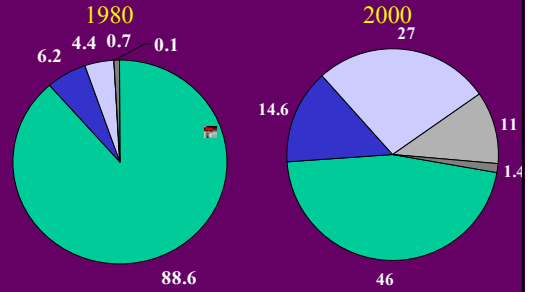
(Percent in Each Racial Group)

### In 2 Decades, Lynn's Child Population Has Gone from About a Tenth to Over Half Minority

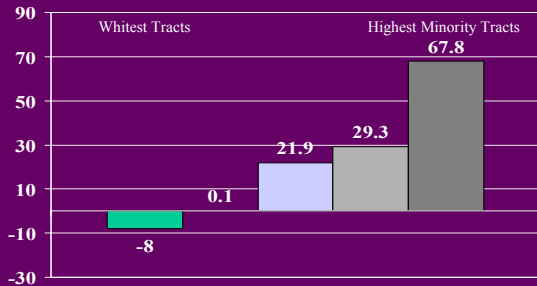

■ White ■ Black ■ Latino ■ Asian ■ Other

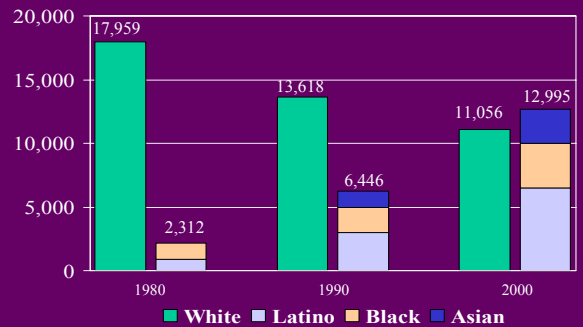
### Child Population Fell Slightly in Whitest Tracts but Grew Dramatically in Highest Minority Tracts

(Percent Change in Child Population: 1980-2000)



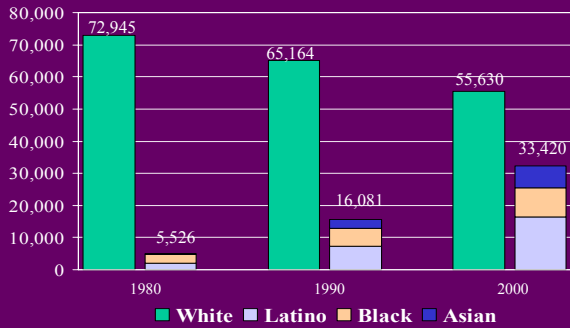
Note: "Whitest tracts" were 81-96% minority in 2000. "Highest Minority Tracts" were 31-36% white in 2000.

Note: Minority Total includes small "other race" group not shown separately.

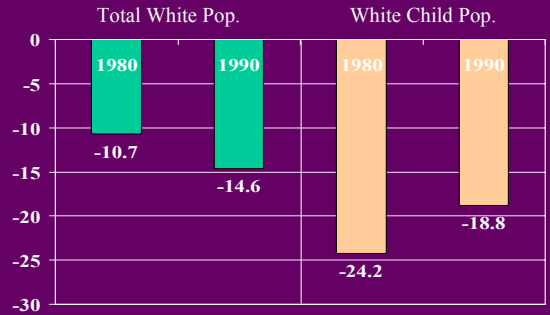
### Minorities Have Grown Rapidly While Number of Whites Declined (Total Population)

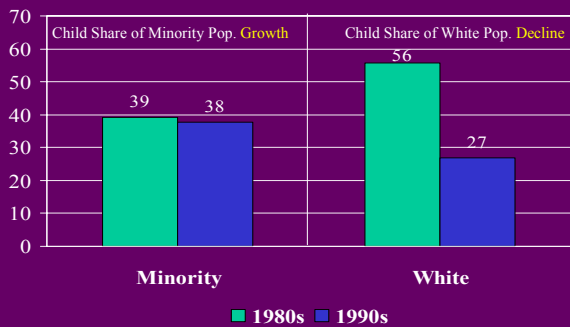
### Decline of the White Child Population Slowed in 1990s

(Percent Change in White Population)



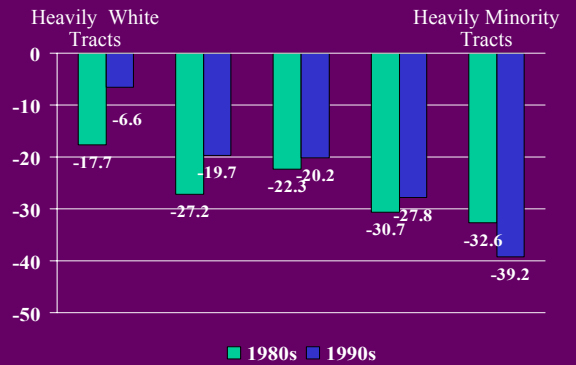
### Child Share of Minority Growth Remains Stable, But Child Share of White Decline Plummets in 1990s

(Percent of Population Change Attributable to Change in Number of Children)



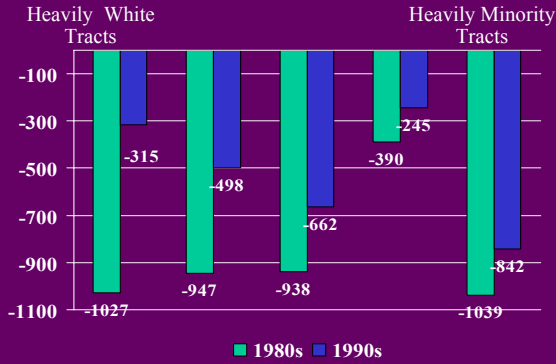
### Whitest Tracts Saw the Most Dramatic Slowing in White Child Loss

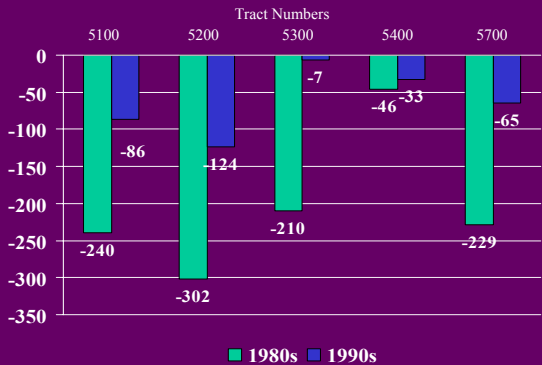


### The Next Five Charts Show the Variation of Change in the White Child Population by Individual Tract.

In Almost All Cases, the Decline of the White Child Population was Less in the 1990s than in the 1980s.

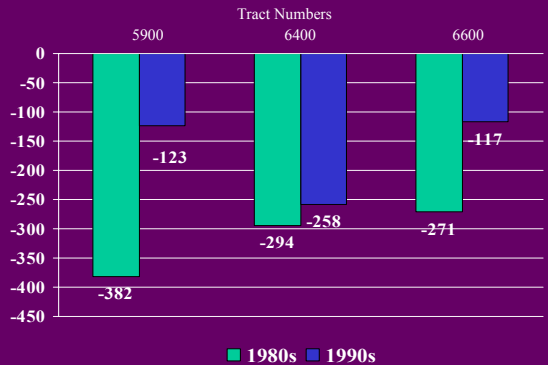
### Almost All of the **Whitest** Tracts Saw Dramatic Slowing in White Child Loss

(Change in Number of White Children in Tracts that Were 81-96% White in 2000)



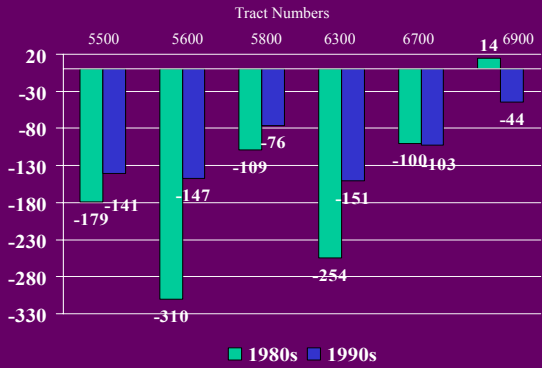
### Most of the Tracts with **Medium-High** White Share Saw Dramatic Slowing in White Child Loss

(Change in Number of White Children in Tracts that Were 70-74% White in 2000)



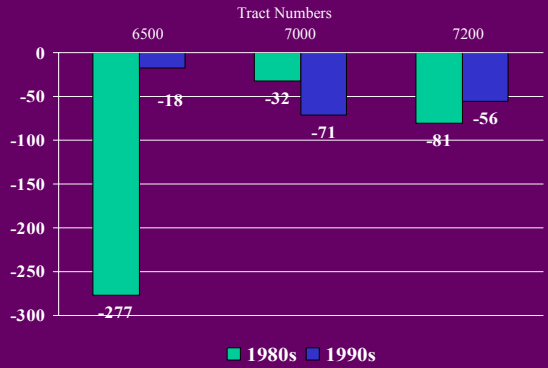
### Most of the Tracts With **Medium** White Share Saw Slowing in White Child Loss

(Change in Number of White Children in Tracts that Were 53-68% White in 2000)



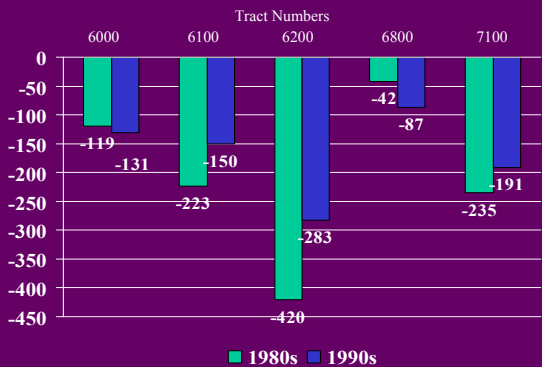
### Most of the Tracts with **Medium-Low** White Share Saw Slowing in White Child Loss
